What is Responsible Consumerism?

- Also called Ethical Consumerism
- "activism based on the premise that purchasers in markets consume not only goods but also, implicitly, the process used to produce them"
- Way to support business that uphold certain ethical standards around the environment and labor
- Can incentivize companies to change their behavior

What is the Supply Chain?

'Entire **network** of entities, directly or indirectly interlinked and interdependent in serving the same consumer or customer. It comprises of **vendors** that supply raw material, **producers** who convert the material into products, **warehouses** that store, **distribution centers** that deliver to the retailers, and **retailers** who bring the product to the ultimate user."

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What Does This Look Like?: A Case Study of Palm Oil

 Palm oil is hugely popular, over 50% of products at the grocery store contain it

 Identified as a high risk product for human trafficking

- Increased popularity has led to deforestation
- Habitat destruction
- Decreased biodiversity



What About the Ingredients List?

- INGREDIENTS: Vegetable Oil, Vegetable Fat, Palm Kernel, Palm Kernel Oil, Palm Fruit Oil, Palmate, Palmitate, Palmolein, Glyceryl, Stearate, Stearic Acid, Elaeis Guineensis, Palmitic Acid, Palm Stearine, Palmitoyl Oxostearamide, Palmitoyl Tetrapeptide-3, Sodium Laureth Sulfate, Sodium Lauryl Sulfate, Sodium Kernelate, Sodium Palm Kernelate, Sodium Lauryl Lactylate/Sulphate, Hyrated Palm Glycerides, Etyl Palmitate, Octyl Palmitate, Palmityl Alcohol
- **CONTAINS**: Palm oil

So...Why Don't We Just Ban Palm Oil?

- Some countries have—sort of
 - EU ban on Palm Oil use in biofuels²
- It's useful
- It's comparatively efficient
 - palm oil makes up 35% of all vegetable oils, grown on just 10% percent of the land allocated to oil crops³
- Palm oil industry supports the livelihoods of millions of workers

 - Fair Trade USA
 - Fair Trade International
